



UC IRVINE EXTENSION • STUDENT SERVICES INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS TRAVEL FORM

This travel form must be submitted and you must obtain a signature on your I-20 from the UC Irvine Extension each time you travel outside the U.S. Please bring your I-20, passport, I-94 (if you have one), and visa prior along with this form when requesting a travel endorsement. It is your responsibility to ensure that your visa and travel documents are in order to re-enter the U.S.

When traveling outside the U.S., please expect that your I-94 card (if you have one) will be taken at the ticket counter upon your check-in. You will be issued a new CBP admission stamp in your passport upon your return to the U.S. Bring a copy of the new CBP admission stamp to our office **within 1 week** of being back in the United States.

If you are not returning to your home country, you should check the visa requirements of the country you are visiting. **Some countries require a visa.** You may need an in-transit visa for countries where you are making a connecting flight. It is your responsibility to check BEFORE you travel. Most countries have immigration websites that provide visa information.

List of Documents Needed for Re-Entry to the United States:

1. Valid Passport
2. Valid F-1 Visa
3. Valid I-20 signed by a DSO at UC Irvine Extension

Customs and Border Protection (CBP) also recommends that you have the following:

1. Evidence of financial resources
2. Evidence of student status (recent tuition receipts, transcripts)
3. Name and contact information for the UC Irvine Extension International Student Advisor (DSO) who signed your I-20

Will you be applying for a new visa?

If your visa expired or you changed visa status while the U.S. you must obtain a new visa prior to re-entry. It is recommended that you apply for a visa in your Country of Residence. Contact the U.S. Consulate where you will apply for a visa for information on visa appointments, document requirements, and application processing times. Citizens of Canada do not require a visa to enter the U.S., but must have appropriate visa documents.

When you return to UC Irvine Extension

Remember to come to the Student Services office **within 1 week** if you received a new Visa, CBP admission stamp, passport or other immigration documents so that we may make copies for your file.
